
STRONG GROWTH IN THE CHINA MARITIME INDUSTRY

INMEX China is the largest and most established international maritime event in the Pearl River Delta Region. According to the China Shipping Development Outlook 2030 report, issued by the Shanghai International Shipping Institute, China will be the world's largest cruise market and Chinese shipyards are expected to get about 11% of the world's cruise ship orders by the year 2030. By then, China is expected to overtake Greece as the top shipping nation.

At the same time, the Chinese Government has indicated that they will be putting in more efforts into the national maritime industry, including fostering world-class high-end marine industrial clusters into Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area, building Shanghai and Shenzhen into global marine centres, improving maritime research through sending up three maritime satellites into space, and promoting maritime legislation by drafting the basic law of the sea. All these represent the enormous potential and huge opportunities in the China maritime industry.



Economic Opportunities of China's Domestic Cruise Construction

China has become the world's second-largest market for cruise travel.

By 2030, the country will become the world's largest cruise market, with 8 to 10 million customers each year, according to figures by the Shanghai International Shipping Institute.

Tap into the buoyant cruise demand of the cruise market in China:

- China's government has earmarked cruise shipbuilding as a major objective in its "Made In China 2025" programme to upgrade its domestic manufacturing and support jobs at its shipyards, as domestic demand for cruise trips increases 30% a year.
- China is a main driver of passenger growth in Asia adding 770,000 more cruise travelers since 2012, a 66% compound annual growth rate.

- World Travel & Tourism Council reported that 17 more cruise ports are scheduled to be built over the next two years, and out of which, 10 more cruise ports will be built in China by 2020.






